Topic 3. Upholding Righteousness: Spiritual Triage

We described “spiritual triage” in these terms: Spiritually Healthy, Spiritually Wounded, Spiritually Dead.

- In which category would you place yourself? Each person in your fellowship family? Others in your realm of relationships? Is it helpful to know what level and kind of ministry someone might need?

- Describe a situation in which someone who was “spiritually dead” (had no intention of repenting and walking in obedient trust) was part of either your fellowship family or circle of relationships. How did that person affect everyone else?

- What are some indicators that someone is bitter? How might their bitterness defile the rest of your fellowship family?

- What biblical method have you established as a fellowship family to deal with an unrepentant person in your extended spiritual family? Why is it important to have discussed this *before* a situation arises?

What attitude should those in your fellowship family have toward the person who has been removed? How would you respond if you ran into that person?

- What if the unrepentant person were married. What do you do about their family?

- How and under what conditions would you receive the person back into your fellowship family?
