Topic 6. Stop The Sacerdotal

- Is your family fellowship a gathering of mutual participation as a body, or do certain people tend to dominate? Are you a sacerdotal, or leaning in that direction?

- How would you handle someone who's trying to control your fellowship family gatherings? Have you ever had to confront this situation? What happened?

- Communication killers we mentioned include: talking too much or too little; cutting off others or completing their sentences; sarcasm or criticism; topic fixation or shifting topics; dwelling in the past or fantasizing about the future. Do any of these describe you or anyone in your family or fellowship?

- How do you handle interruption, sarcasm or rudeness? Ask others to evaluate you.

- Which relationships do you now have that would benefit by changing from “talk AT” to “talk WITH”? How do you think those individuals would respond if you brought this up to them?

- Describe your interaction with members of the opposite sex in your extended spiritual family. Do you make them apprehensive? Ask for feedback.

- How have you handled situations in which verbal sparring threatened the peace of your gathering as a fellowship family, or in other group situations? How did others respond?
