THE GENUINE'S LIFE EVIDENCES OUR LORD JESUS

The *Genuine* Possess The Obedient Trust Of Abraham

A Holy Spirit-guided/empowered way of life is promised in the New Covenant.

Dear Friends in Christ Jesus our Lord,

In this Nugget we reinforce the “vertical”, the spiritual element of how you’re to live if you are *genuinely* born again. It’s crucial that you fully understand the Hebraic foundations by which our Father is restoring the vertical, obedience-based trust relationship with the *genuinely* born again which He had with Abraham, His friend. Don’t brush aside how indispensable this understanding is to your own spiritual life. (♥If these truths didn’t need to be restored, Father wouldn’t be restoring them around the world.)



It’s essential that you realize that God extended to Abraham an eternal covenant of blessing (Genesis 12:2,3). This covenant was ultimately fulfilled in the New Covenant by the patriarch’s Seed in the physical realm, our Lord Jesus. God’s regard for the obedient trust of Abraham was demonstrated in the patriarch being told the Gospel in advance (Galatians 3:8). If you are *genuine*, the core of the vertical in the New Covenant is the preciousness of your *interactive, obedient trust relationship* with your heavenly Father and Lord Jesus Who love you so abundantly. And it is the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit in the *genuinely* born again Who makes this intimate love relationship possible. The horizontal element of this relationship in union with our Lord Jesus is the physical world where your love-grounded obedient trust in your heavenly Father is lived out among other people.

!!!When you’ve eradicated any vestiges of self-serving religious practices formulated by anti-Semitic theology, you find that the Bible’s vertical emphasis on obedient trust strongly motivates you to fulfill your heavenly Father’s purposes for you, and for you to become more like the Lord you love as you actively serve as His ambassador. This is Scripture living that’s void of theology!

“In Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we might receive the promised Spirit through faith” (Galatians 3:14).

Again, through the Hebraic foundations, our Father is restoring the preeminence of the vertical, obedience-based relationship which Abraham, the father of every *genuine in Christ*, enacted (Romans 4:16; Galatians 3:7,9). Abraham lived obedience-based because he had a firm understanding of the vertical. He didn’t need laws to keep him obedient; rather, he related to God as his Lord. For the *genuine*, the Spirit of our Lord Jesus in each of us is the personal embodiment of Immanuel, ***“God with us.”*** If it weren’t for the centuries of domination by the Nicolaitan clergy system, a vast number of today’s nominal Christians might authentically convert and live as Abraham lived: fully relating to our heavenly Father and Lord Jesus as They desire. Keep in mind that our Lord despises this system He refers to as “Nicolaitanism” because it places men between Him and His followers. Nicolaitan means “to conquer the people.” Here’s what Lord Jesus says about it: *“You also have those who hold to the teaching of the Nicolaitans. REPENT, or else I will soon come to you and will fight against them with the sword of My mouth”* (Revelation 2:15,16).

In our April 12, 2013 Teaching Email, [**A Year Older and Very Saddened**](#), Mike wrote:

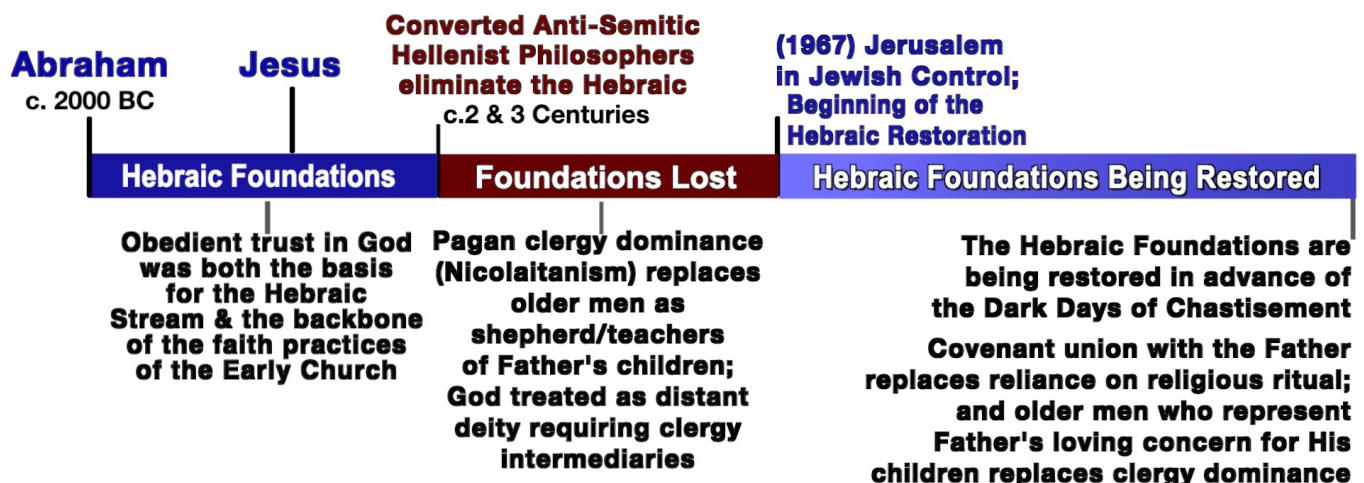
“I turned 67 a few days ago. While it's not a particularly significant age, I have to admit I don't look forward to ever turning 68. Over the course of my life thus far I've witnessed the destruction of this nation, family by family. I've especially observed so many botched opportunities for Christian men to have kept this rapid downward spiral from ever happening, never mind escalating. I've grieved that the majority of men I've met who claim they're Christian have been dominated by **cowardice, fear** and **their widespread toleration for sin**. Because of their own choice to shrink back, they have remained collectively impotent as demonic principalities have infiltrated and overcome this country.”



We recently celebrated our 56th wedding anniversary on 2/21/2026, and our Lord willing, Mike will turn 80 on April 7. Our depth of sadness has only increased since 2013 over the growing spiritual darkness and worldly compromise within Christianity in the US. Yet what encourages us to continue sharing with you what the Holy Spirit reveals to us is this: that we know beyond doubt that our heavenly Father foresaw this nation's downfall which would precede the Hebraic foundations bearing fruit among those indoctrinated by various forms of **anti-Semitic theology**. The chastisement of the US is part our Father's plan because of the pervasive toleration of sin and the cowardice of so many men. But in advance He has been sending forth the truths of the Hebraic foundations for the *genuine* to prepare themselves now. May you be among these...

The Hebraic Foundations

Once Disregarded Are Now Being Restored



The Holy Spirit prompted us to review with you the biblical backdrop to the Hebraic foundations, and how our Father recruited us to share these truths. It seems that the more we've matured by grace in living the Hebraic foundations out of love for our Lord Jesus, the more we've matured in our understanding of our specific spiritual anointing in sharing these truths. His timing of these truths being restored to those with “ears to hear” is key. During our years of ministry we're grieved by how few Christians we've encountered are living impassioned about doing our Father's will and living under the rule of our Lord Jesus, guided by His Spirit.

“Therefore know that only those who are of faith are children of Abraham” (Galatians 3:7).



The Hebraic foundations are our heavenly Father's way of restoring the vertical trusting obedience of His friend, Abraham. Our Lord Jesus is the exemplary role model of the vertical commanding the horizontal way of living. His ancestor Abraham is an earthly example to us of that obedient trust. If your fervent desire is to experience the vertical, trusting obedience which our heavenly Father is restoring, you must let your mind keep being transformed until you become totally Spirit-led. Abraham's willingness to be called out of the familiar (see Genesis 15) is a vibrant example for you.



This may mean that you refuse to “fellowship” with nominal Christians whose spiritual lives are a **sham**, *people who pretend to be someone or something they are not*. Purposing out of love for Jesus to develop and grow in the same obedient trust as Abraham is hindered when you choose to worship with people who you know are compromising with sin but enjoy the social aspects of “church”. We know this because we chose to follow the leading of the Holy Spirit and fled the sham of nominal Christianity and the domination of Nicolaitan clergy. We yearned to personally relate to our Father no less than Abraham did—and all the more intimately because of the Spirit of Christ indwelling us. If you choose to live with this depth of relational intimacy, we can assure you that our Father will test your obedient trust to verify that it's for real. The Older Testament offers numerous examples and insights of testing (Psalm 105:18-19; Judges 7:4; Psalms 11:5; Proverbs 17:3, et al.). And Peter affirms that testing comes to the *genuine*: *“You have been grieved by various trials, that the genuineness of your [obedient] trust, being much more precious than gold that perishes though tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ”* (1Peter 1:6b,7; see also 1Thessalonians 2:4).

***“Surely the Lord God does nothing without revealing
His plan to His servants the prophets”*** (Amos 3:7).

We'd like you to know why the Hebraic foundations were given to a prophetic man to share, and why these have been most effectively shared through other prophets. Before the foundations were revealed to us, the Spirit told Mike through Jeremiah 1:17-19 what the nature of our ministry would be like. And after 32 years of sharing, these verses have been well substantiated.

Since the 1980s four biblical anointings are being restored, beginning with the biblical role of the prophet. (Tragically, anti-Semitic theology and Nicolaitan clergy-system domination which was introduced into Christianity from the pagan Greeks eradicated the full use of our Lord's anointings.) Prayerfully read our Lord's purposes for which these four anointings are being restored. Then we'll explain what the Spirit revealed as to why the prophet in particular needed to be restored:

*“[Jesus] gave some to be **apostles**, some to be **prophets**, some to be **evangelists**, and some to be **shepherds/teachers**, ➤to equip the saints for the work of ministry, ➤for building up the body of Christ, ➤until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, ➤to mature manhood, ➤to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ, ➤so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes. Rather, ➤speaking the truth in love, ➤we are to grow up in every way into Him who is the Head, into Christ, from Whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, ➤when each part is working properly, ➤makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love”* (Ephesians 4:11-16).

There are currently 45,000+ divisions throughout Christendom, each believing they hold the truth. So you can understand how vital the Christ-ordained four anointings are for Him alone to be lifted up among those who are authentically His. Reflect on the various roles of the apostle, prophet, evangelists, and shepherd/teacher. Now picture how essential the prophet's role in particular is in being **wholly vertically-oriented**. A prophet's mission is enacted from the voice of the Spirit of our Lord: *"For the testimony of Jesus is the Spirit of prophecy"* (Revelation 19:10; see also 2Peter 1:20,21). A prophet does nothing without hearing the voice of our Lord's Spirit dictating •who to go to, and •what He wants shared. To be always prepared to hear the voice of our Lord's Spirit, the prophet must live repentantly and humble to serve as our Lord's messenger. It's the prophet's loving appreciation for what his (or her) Lord Jesus did for him that enables him to live as an unworthy servant who is only doing his duty (Luke 17:10).

By contrast, the mission of the shepherd/teacher (an older man of wisdom who represents our heavenly Father's care for His children) is for the most part horizontally-oriented. He and his flock are strengthened by the vertical focus of the prophet, who equips them to make love-grounded obedient trust in the vertical primary in their lives. He also serves as a voice of our Lord to encourage and/or correct them as necessary. An apostle's primary role is to fulfill specific missions for our Lord. An evangelist is both a faith community planter and repairer. These roles stretch the flock to live sacrificially on behalf of our Lord, their only Head (Colossians 1:18; 2:19).

Mike: In reflecting back on my own life as a prophet of our Lord, I've come to appreciate that as a prophet matures, he learns to view his role as an instrument of mercy of our Lord Jesus. Because of amazing mercy our Lord became man to reveal His Father's loving concern for humanity (John 3:16,17), and to reconcile them to Him (Romans 5:11; 2Corinthians 5:18). The Spirit also uses a prophet to reconcile those who are holding onto unconfessed sin back to the fellowship which our Father longs to have restored. Our Father highly regards the humble and repentant: *"I dwell in the high and holy place, and with him who has a contrite and lowly spirit, to revive the spirit of the lowly, and to revive the heart of the contrite"* (Isaiah 57:15). A prophet realizes that the harsher the warning that the Spirit of our Lord gives him to confront an unrepentant person, the greater is the need for these intense words to stop the person from continuing to sin and to restore them to cherishing the fellowship their sin severed.

The prophet's ministry is made much easier by the humble and repentant who are thankful that someone cared enough about their spiritual condition to reveal to them their sin which has ruptured their fellowship with our Father (1John 1:5-10). But, with the ever-increasing influence of Humanism within much of Christianity and its ME-centered obsession devoid of moral boundaries, my role as a prophet who has been sent to reconcile people with God is much more difficult. The prophecy of Isaiah which both our Lord Jesus and Paul repeat applies throughout Christianity today, *"You will be ever hearing but never understanding; you will be ever seeing but never perceiving"* (Matthew 13:14; Acts 28:26).

Anyone who is serving as a prophet humbly knows that by no means are you perfect, nor are you more special because you hear His Spirit's voice. Our Lord Himself recruited you to be His agent to speak on His behalf. The phrase, **"others may, but you may not"** particularly applies to a prophet because their ministry is anchored in living repentantly and led by the Spirit. And, it's vital that if you're *genuinely* born again, be totally confident that you also can hear the Spirit's 'voice' within you. This can occur as you pray or read your Bible, and through gifts like prophecy, exhortation, wisdom, and knowledge. **If you do want to hear His voice of guidance, you must stay repentant and be ready to do whatever He tells you.** In light of this we encourage you: **"Today, if you hear His voice, do not harden your hearts"** (Hebrews 4:7; see also Matthew 4:4).
